


iPad Podcast Project Guide

Saving Images from the Web



1. Tap the icon on the bottom of your iPad.
2. Tap the URL field at the top and type in the website that you wish to retrieve your photos from. (Alternatively, you can use the Google field to search for key words.)
3. When you find the image that you are looking for, tap and hold on the image until you see a menu pop up, giving you options such as: Open, Open in New Page, Save Image, or Copy (see below). Tap "Save Image" and these images will automatically save to your Photos library.



Taking a Photo or Recording a Video with the iPad's Camera

1. Tap the Camera icon.
2. Use the slider on the bottom right to choose between still photos (a camera icon) and videos (a movie camera icon).
3. Tap the center button to take a picture or stop/start recording a video.
4. Pictures and Videos are saved in the Photos library. You can access Photos from the home screen and tapping on the Photos icon.

Starting a New Project in iMovie

1. Launch iPad by going to the home screen (you might have to press the home button) and tap the iMovie icon:

3. Tap the "+" icon to start a new iMovie project.

Editing an Existing Project in iMovie



1. Tap the iMovie icon to launch iMovie:
2. Tap a project to begin editing the project.

Inserting Photos into your iMovie Project


1. Click on the icon that looks like a camera (on the bar to the left) and a screen will pop up that says "Camera Roll". Click this menu option, and it will take you to your page of photos.
2. To place images onto your movie stream, tap on the picture you want and it will jump onto the movie stream. To move the picture, just hold and drag the picture around the movie stream.
3. To adjust its display time, tap on the photo on the movie stream until a yellow border surrounds it then pinch or expand the photo (you will notice that a little box next to the photo will by default say 6.0s, however this will change depending on narrow or wide you make the photo show up on the stream).

Inserting Videos into your iMovie Project

1. To insert a video that you recorded with the iPad's camera, tap on the square icon on the left side of iMovie.
2. Move the video stream (if needed) so that the red vertical line is right where you want to insert the video clip.
3. Tap on the video clip that you want and tap on the arrow to insert the clip into your project.


Recording a Voice-over Narration

1. First, be sure your photos and/or videos are arranged in the order you want on the movie stream.
2. Second, PRACTICE your narration a couple of times to make sure you have the pacing just right. (See step 3 in "Inserting Photos" to see how to lengthen or shorten the duration of a photo display time.)
3. When you are ready, press the microphone button on the right of the screen. Then, press "record" and it will prompt you to start recording after the countdown. Tap the stop button when you are finished narrating.
4. To move recordings, tap on the purple recording bar in your stream and drag the yellow bar till the recording is in the appropriate place.



Adding Text to a iMovie Project

1. To add text to your video, double tap a clip in your movie stream and a "Clip Setting" menu will pop up. Tap "Title Style".
2. If you would like your text before or after the clip, select the "Opening" or "Ending" option. If you would like an overlay title, select the "Middle" option.
3. To edit text, double tap the dotted box that pops up on the image and type your desired text.
